Because of you, we are an engaged, and engaging, community. In short, you are an awesome and holy group. Kol HaKavod! To each of you goes the honor for increasing the joy of this season in so many ways.

Please remember to carry the messages of my various talks with you as you journey through 5776:

- 1) Like the FitBit that tracks our exercise over the course of a day, we should each have a Mitzvah Tracker so that we can set mitzvah goals and check on them.
- 2) In these times of growing anti-Semitism, remember all of the wonderful things that the Jewish people have introduced to the world, beginning with the concept of One God and that we are created in God's image. We need to be ambassadors for our people.
- 3) With anti-Israel rhetoric moving to a crescendo and the BDS movement gaining steam, it is important to note the good things that Israel does around the world, from teaching Third-world farmers about water conservation, to sending medical teams to countries that have suffered natural disasters. We need to be ambassadors for Israel.
- 4) The Iran controversy is bad enough, but the impact of the fracture it has caused within the Jewish community may be even worse. The Second Temple was destroyed because of "Sinat Chinam", baseless hatred of one Jew for another. Though we may have disagreements, we need to at all times be respectful of each other.
- 5) We connect with God in many ways, usually at moments of peak emotion. If a successful advertisement can take a mundane item and make it "special", thereby creating a need for connection, then we should be able to take a "Special" item, like God, and make the Deity more "ordinary" and thereby foster connection.

As always, I encourage you to reach out to me with your thoughts and ideas on the High Holy Days or anything else that may be on your mind.
